From the treacherous road trip to their new village home, to learning to navigate a new culture, to a stateside mission field in Vermont, Moston's journey reveals that God leads just as clearly today as he did in biblical times. Her candid account tells a story of learning to trust and obey when faithfulness seems foolish. Written with humor and insight, *Call of a Coward* is an engaging reminder that with our very real God in control, cowards become courageous and ordinary people find great purpose. *We will meet Wednesday, May 24 at 6:00 p.m. in the Conference Room.
