There is a Korean soccer player called Son Heung-min. He is shaking the world because he scored 23 goals in England's Premier League, which is considered the center of world soccer league. He earned the highest score of the year award. They said this is the first award for an Asian athlete. His award is even more meaningful because all goals were scored purely on a ground without a penalty kick. Unusually, if you watch him playing, he can freely use both right and left feet, so he scores with both feet. Especially, his 23rd goal was a goal that caused him to roll off his feet even though it was an area with a low success rate due to considerable distance.

All soccer experts say that Son's success is because the basics are well trained. When he was growing up, Son received personal soccer training from his father. Son's father trained him sufficiently by repeating the basics. When he was a child, he had sufficiently trained the basics of physical strength, and some techniques were repeated every day. Today's Son Heung-min is the result of bloody training. The reason his father focused on basic training for young player Son Heung-min was because of his painful memories. His father was a soccer player, but he unfortunately suffered an injury, which put him on the verge of quitting his dream of playing early. And in order for a young son on the path to become a soccer player to become a successful player without getting injured, he believed that training in basic skills at an early age would be the way to success, so he applied it.

This makes me to think about the importance of basic skills which is necessary not only for exercise, but also for study and our faith. We must learn, train, and obtain basic skills in order to be more effective and better athletes for God. The better you train the basic skills of faith from an early age, the more likely you are to lead a life of faith. So, it is very important to start early training in the




